During the disability of the Mayor or in case of a vacancy in that office, the President of the Council exercises all powers and discharges all duties of the Mayor. The City Council consists of 15 members (16 with the president), 12 elected from single member districts and 3 elected at-large. The President is elected from the city at-large and presides at all meetings.

The Board of Ethics is an independent, citizen-appointed board that works to ensure honesty, openness, and integrity in city government through enforcing the city's ethical standards of conduct. The purpose of the Code of Ethics is to (1) prohibit conflicts of interest; (2) require public disclosure of assets and income of elected officials and certain employees; and (3) provide a fair process for addressing ethical questions and disciplining violators. The Ethics Code covers: conflicts of interest, financial disclosure, gifts, gratuities, tickets, outside employment and extra jobs, post-employment rule, solicitations, representing private interests before city agencies, travel, meals and refreshments, use of city time services and property, and use of confidential information. The board's staff provides ethics training, gives advice about the law, administers the financial disclosure program, accepts complaints, conducts investigations, and brings enforcement actions.

The Board of Ethics is composed of seven city residents elected by legal, business, civic, and educational groups to serve a three-year term of office.

If you do not receive your Voter Precinct Card after two weeks call the Fulton County Voter Registration office at 404-612-7072 or the Elections Division at the Georgia Secretary of State at 404-656-2871.

The information on a Voter Precinct cards varies depending on where the voter lives. While most citizens have one polling place, some have a second polling place for city elections. Some cities are divided into Wards, others into City Council Districts.
